To clarify: gifts to the CVCF Fund are matched to the CVCF Fund; gifts to the Fitness and Wellness Fund, Memorial Fund and Environmental Fund are also matched to the CVCF Fund. Gifts made directly to the CVCF Endowed Operating Fund, which is structured to support the long-term operation of CVCF's work, will be matched directly to the Endowed Operating Fund.

Planned Giving: Join the Legacy Society

The Legacy Society provides a unique opportunity for donors to include CVCF in their estate plans, supporting nonprofits of the Chilkat Valley in perpetuity. Planned giving is set up so that everyone wins.

While your assets remain untouched during your lifetime, your planned gift helps build the 'community permanent fund' for the future. Gifts can include a specific dollar amount, a percentage of your after-tax and expenses estate, or a gift of real property, stocks, art work, or other valuables.

Your designation of a CVCF fund as beneficiary reduces the taxable value of your estate, while preserving the full value of your support, since your gift won't be subject to estate and income taxes.

Currently, thanks to The Alaska Community Foundation and Rasmuson Foundation, a 'declaration of intent' is all that's necessary for 5% of your intended Legacy gift to be matched dollar-for-dollar through 2020. (Capped at \$5,000 per bequest gift.)

Make your legacy a reality: work with a CVCF representative to complete a Legacy Society Declaration of Intent form, which includes your name, address, and information about the planned gift you intend to make (fund name and estimated value based on today's value), and then submit it to chilkatvalley@alaskacf.org.
